

THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FARM BROADCASTING PRESENTS **THE PLAMBECK AWARD**



Purpose

To give recognition for the best Single and Series radio commercial(s) broadcast on NAFB STATIONS & NETWORKS designed to inform, influence and motivate the target demographic to respond in a positive manner to achieve communication's objectives.

This award is named in honor of past NAFB president and Hall of Fame member Herb Plambeck.

Criteria

Commercial(s) MUST have been broadcast on NAFB stations and or networks between October 1, 2008 and September 30, 2009.

Demonstrate the creative presentation to best use the farm radio medium in communicating the advertiser's message to the target audience.

May be :30 second or :60 second in length. There is one award for Single entry category and one for the Series category.

Panel of Judges

The selection of the winners will be made by a panel of five judges composed of three farmers/ranchers, one advertising industry representative, and a past president of NAFB.

ONLY ONE WINNER IN EACH CATEGORY (SINGLE ENTRY AND SERIES) WILL BE NAMED.

Entry Deadline

All entries will be submitted to NAFB before September 23, 2009.

There is no charge for entries. Emails or CD's with audio files in MP3 format are preferred.

The Plambeck Award will be presented at the NAFB Convention in Kansas City on Thursday, November 12 at the Night of Honors Banquet.
